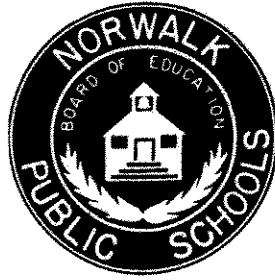
Dear Parents,

- Will there be a bathroom?

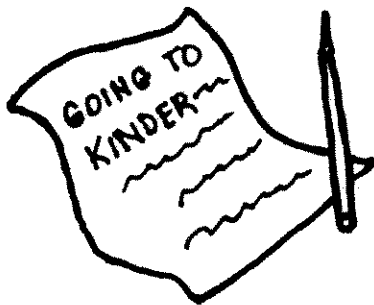

A nice poem entitled "Me"!

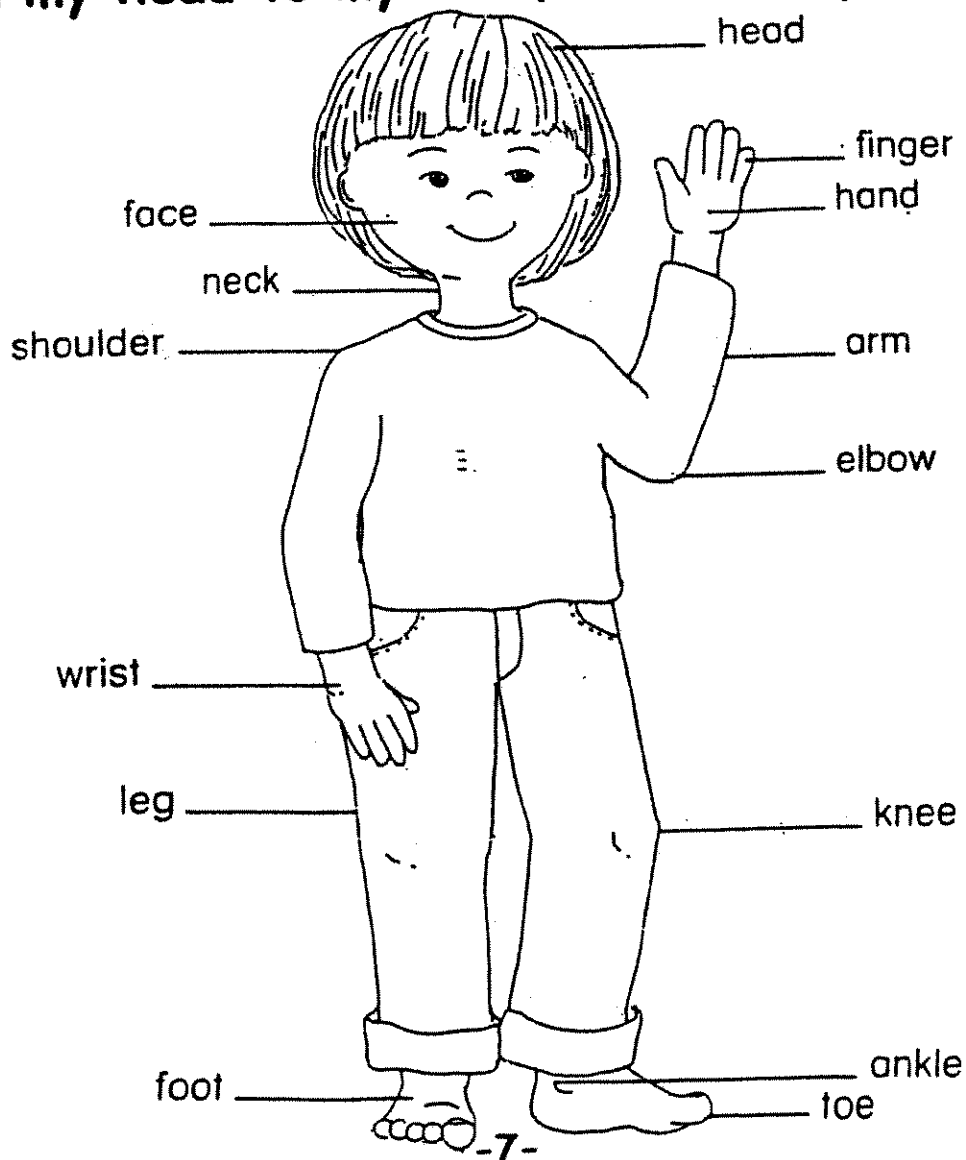

This is me from my head to my toes.

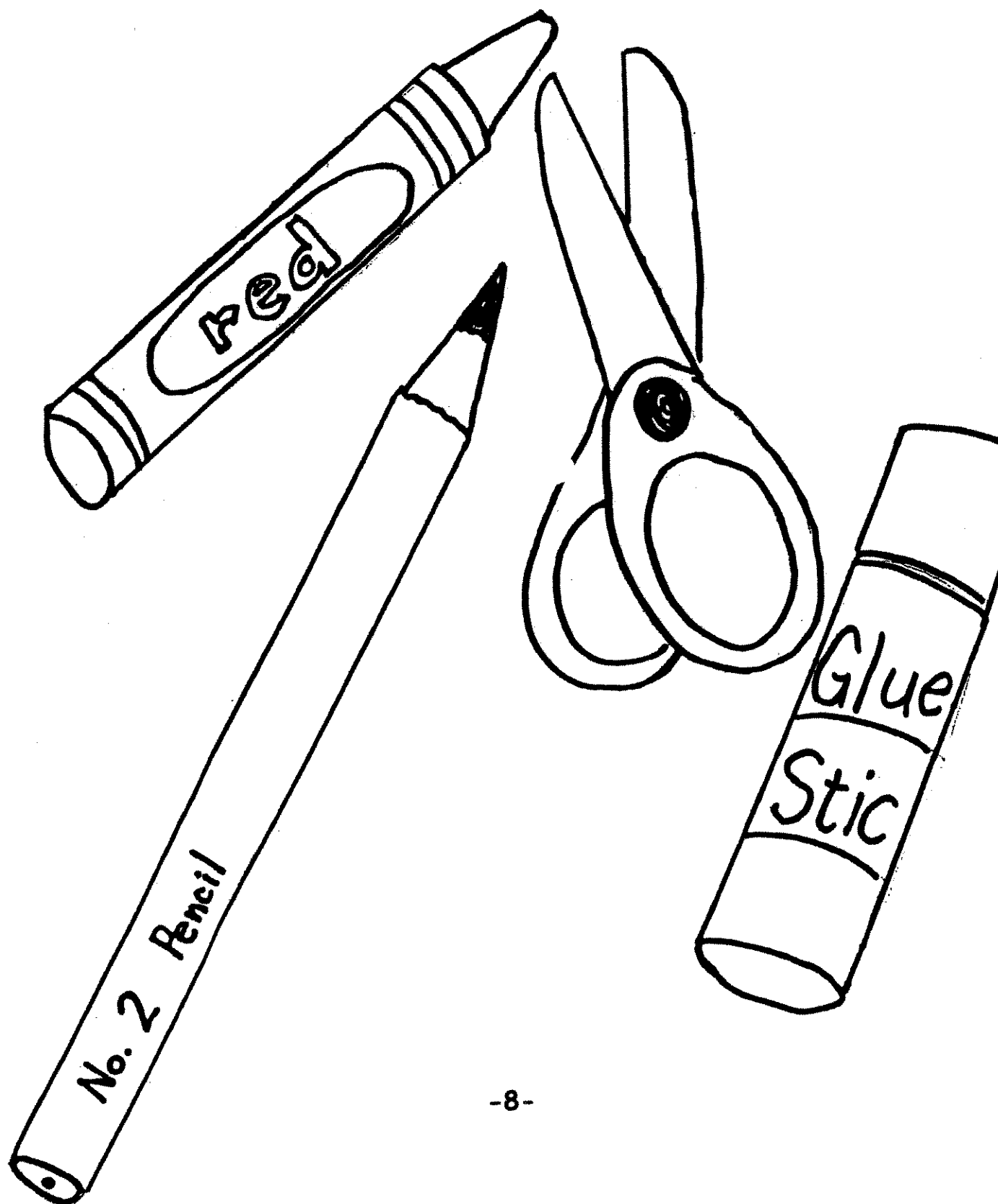
I have two eyes and one little nose.

I can wiggle my ears and stamp my feet.

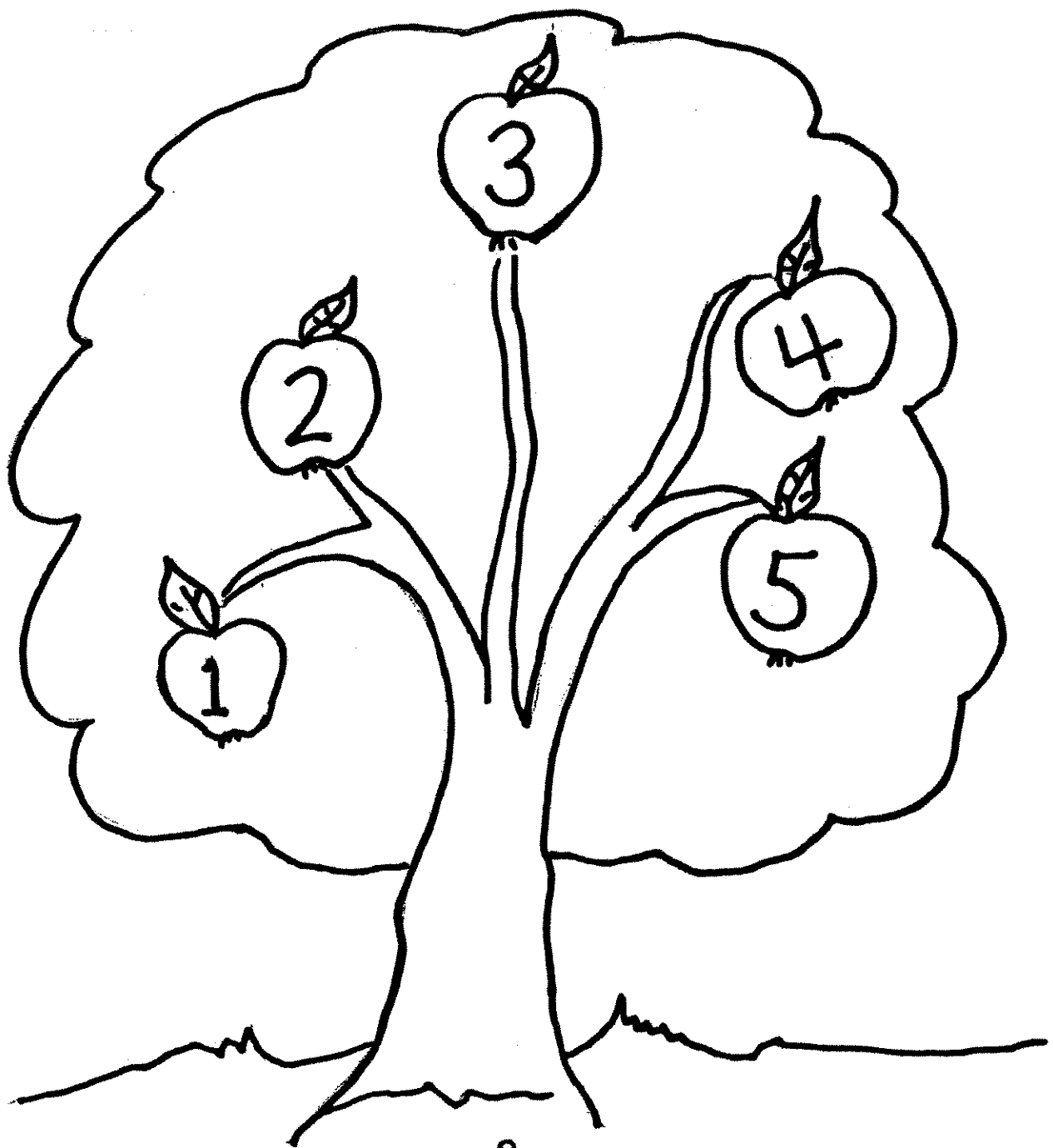
From my head to my toes, I am really neat!



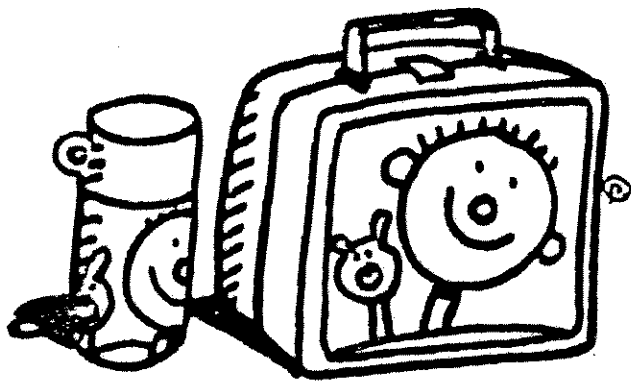
In kindergarten I will color, cut, draw and glue.
There will be so many fun things to do.



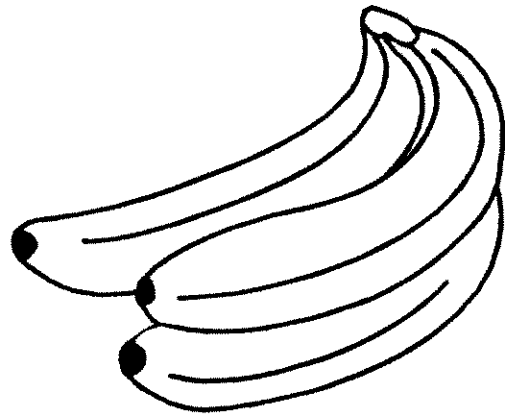
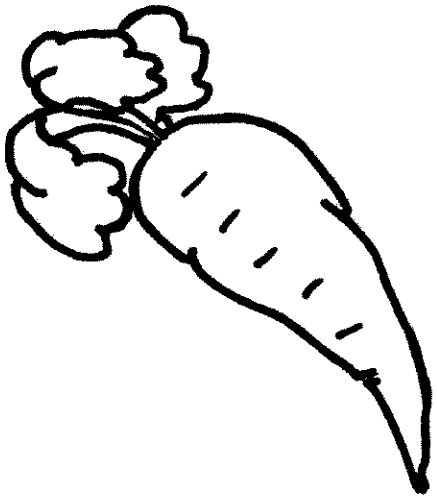
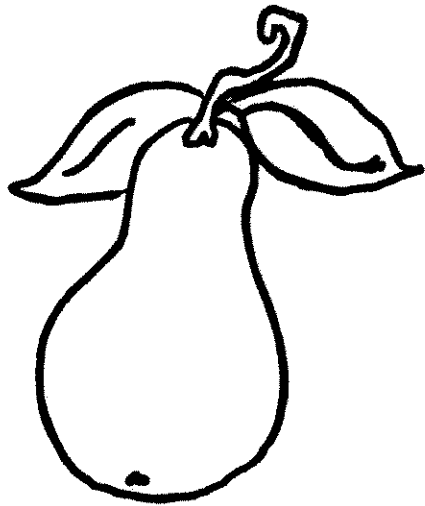
I love to count the things I see,
So look, 1,2,3 4,5 apples in the tree.



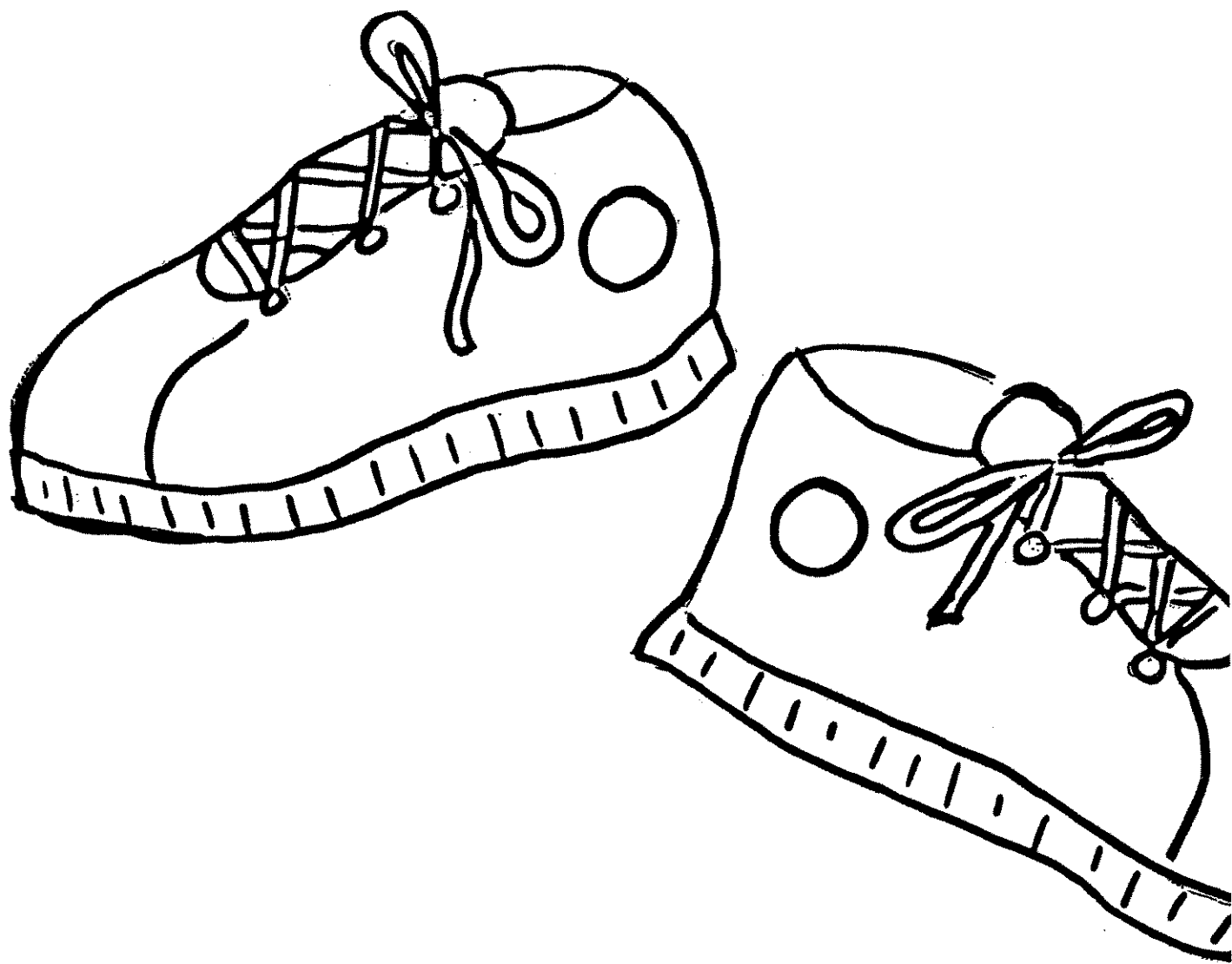
In the lunchroom when it's time to eat,
I will get my lunch and take my seat.



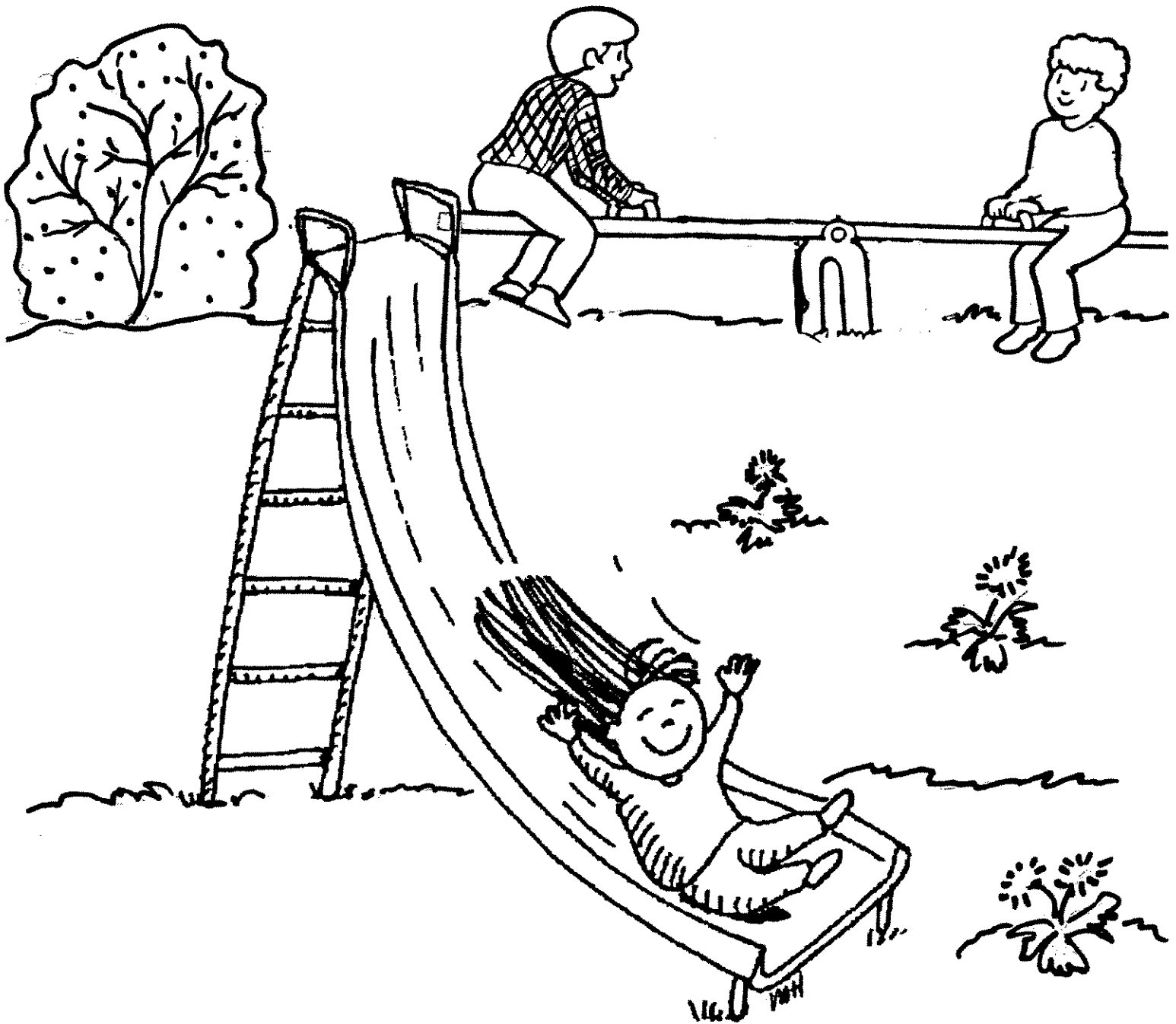
With healthy foods, I can't go wrong,
They give me energy and make me strong.



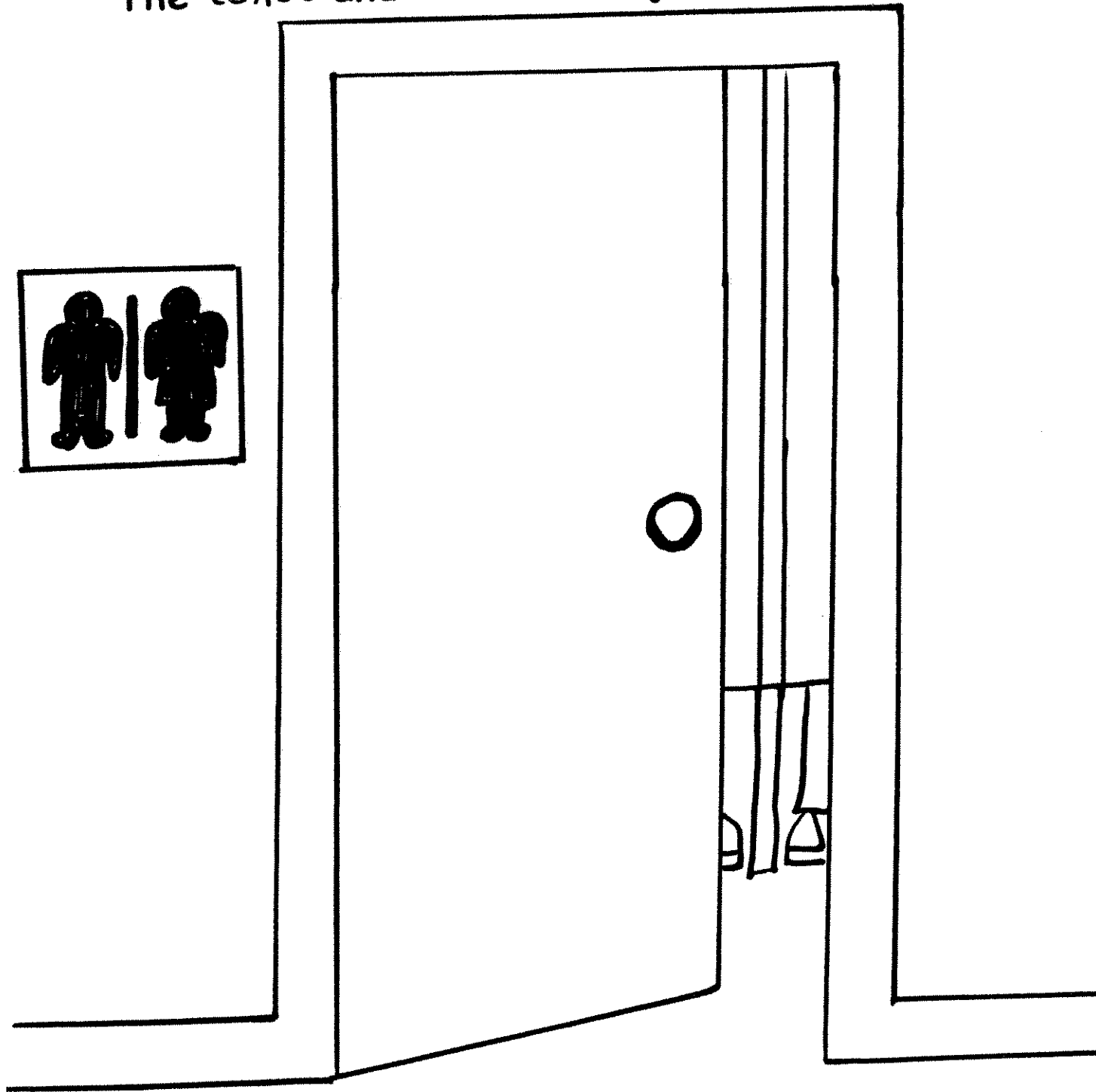
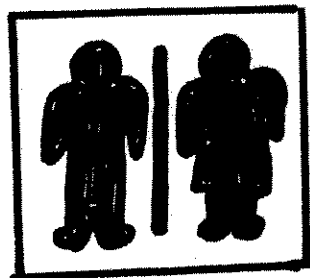
I like to run and jump and play,
So I will wear my sneakers on gym day.



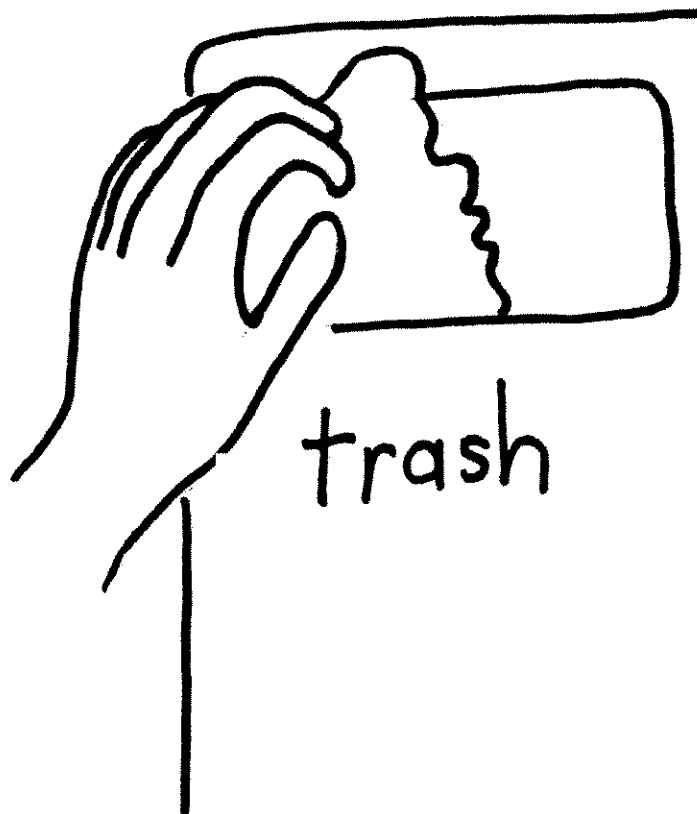
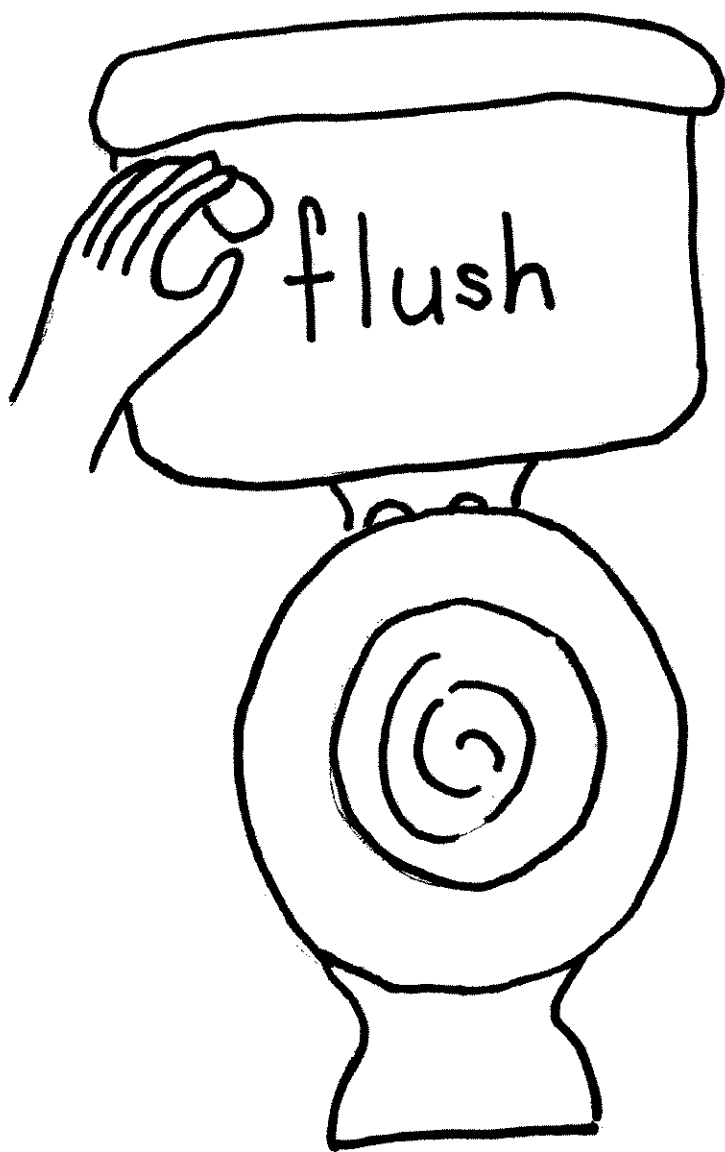
On the playground, I will learn and have fun.

The nurse will call home in a hurry.



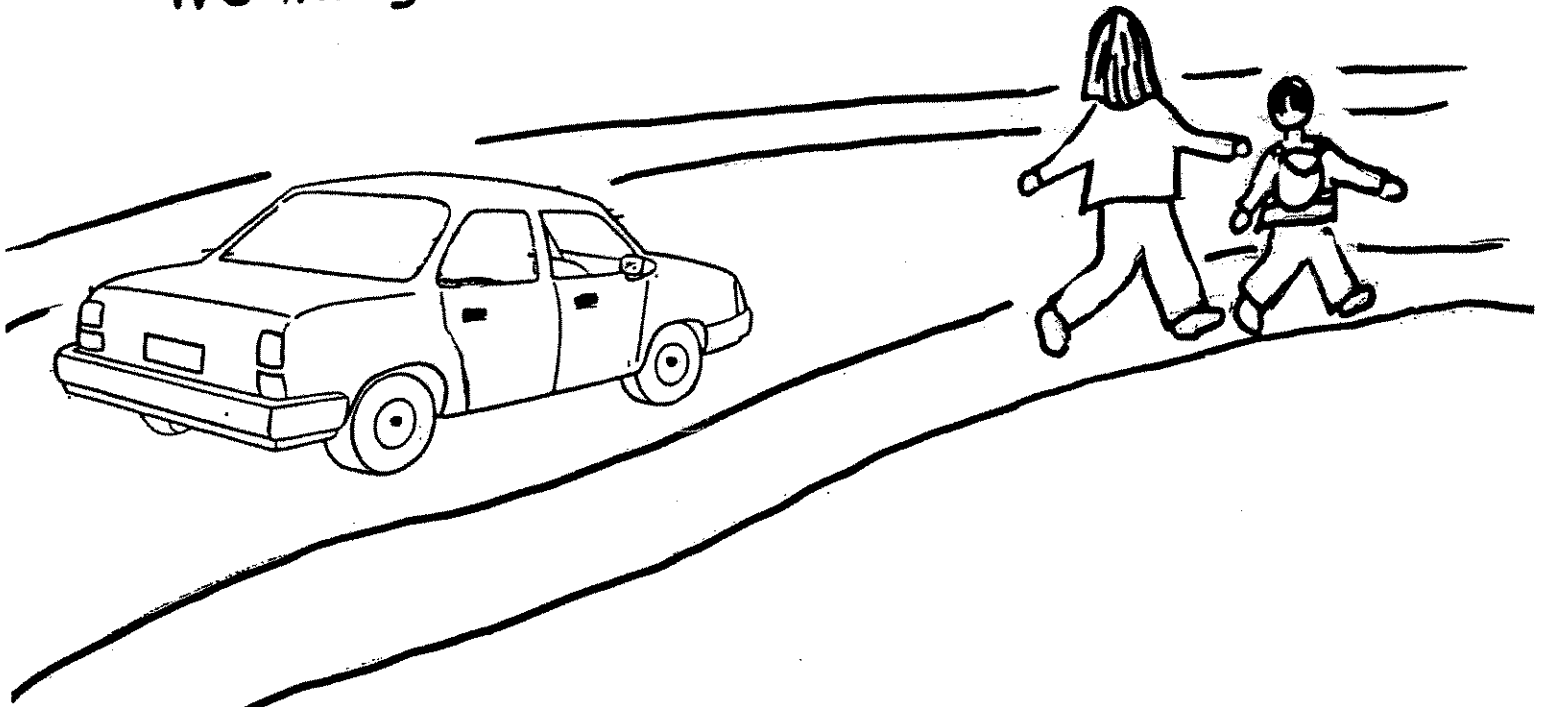
At my new school I know there will be,

She knows where we go at the end of the day.

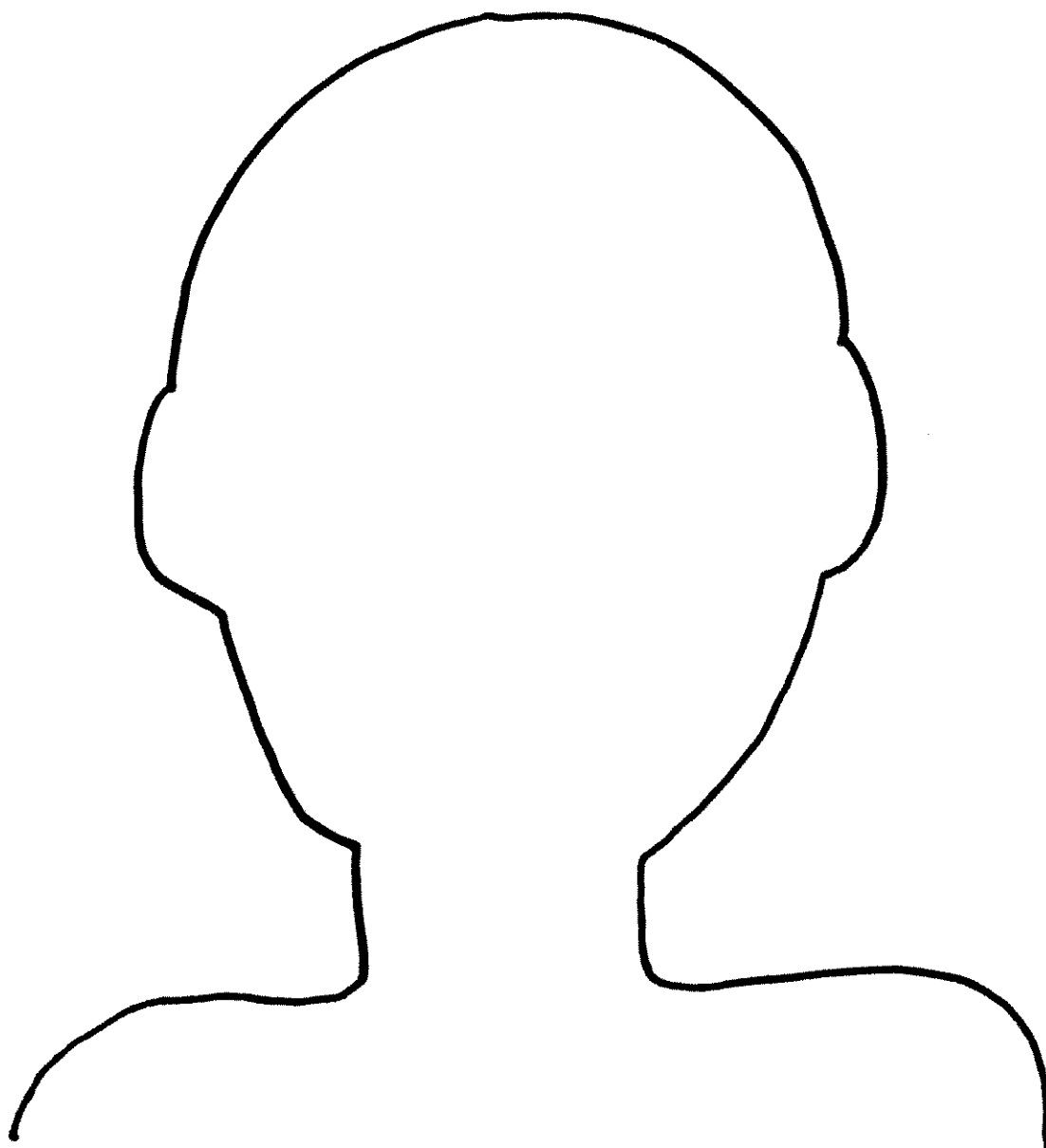


If we walk, ride with our mom or hop on a bus,
